Grapes

Black Monukka

Seedless	Table, Raisins	Black
-----------------	-----------------------	--------------

Medium sized black seedless table grape with tender skin. Excellent crisp, sweet flavor. Good fresh or for raisins. Although a very old variety it is one of the best eating grapes. Bunches are medium-large and loose. Flavor is crisp and sweet. Cane or spur pruning. Ripens August into September.

Canadice

Seedless	Table, Wine, Juice	Red
-----------------	---------------------------	------------

Early ripening and can tolerate sub-zero temperatures. It produces medium clusters with small red berries that have a spicy grape taste. Excellent for fresh use, good for juice, jelly, and wine. Vigorous grower, sets lots of fruit reliably. Ripens late August-early Sept.

Seedless Concord

Seedless	Table, Juice	Red
-----------------	---------------------	------------

Same as the original Concord, just no seeds! Plump grapes have deep purple color, plenty of juice. Medium, well-filled clusters. Fruit has a green, pulpy flesh. Vigor and productivity improve as the vine becomes established. Ripens about a week earlier than Concord. Berries are slightly smaller than Concord. *In warm years, the variety produces fully developed seeds. Ripens August-September.

Crimson

Seedless	Table	Red
-----------------	--------------	------------

The Crimson Seedless boasts a crisp-juicy texture and an excellent, sweet flavor. The vine is extremely vigorous, and the grapes are medium in size and grows in large tightly packed, triangular-shaped clusters. Ripens in October

Einset

Seedless	Table	Red
-----------------	--------------	------------

Einset is an early season variety with delicious, tender flesh. Bright red oval berries are seedless, with a distinctive strawberry jam taste! The medium-sized clusters produce bright red, oval berries with tender skin. Ripens Early

Flame

Seedless	Table, Juice, Raisin	Red
-----------------	-----------------------------	------------

Red, crisp, sweet fruit. Good for fresh use, or it also a good raisin. Firm skin resists cracking. Produces medium-sized clusters of large, sweet, juicy grapes. High vigor and productivity. America's most popular red seedless grape! Ripens early

Glenora

Seedless	Table	Blue/Black
-----------------	--------------	-------------------

Tastes like Blueberries! Vines yield huge clusters of juicy, medium to large grapes with deep, blue-black color. Seedless. Sweet, spicy, fine textured, highly flavored flesh. Keeps well on the vine. Red-orange autumn foliage. Ripens in mid August.

Himrod

Seedless	Table	Green
-----------------	--------------	--------------

The Himrod produces large bunches of medium size tender-skinned greenish-white berries with sweet, delicious, honey-like flavor and melting, juicy texture. Ripens very early

Interlaken

Seedless	Table, Raisins	Green
-----------------	-----------------------	--------------

Has a strong, pleasant, tangy flavor, excellent for fresh eating or raisins. Vigorous, disease resistant, bearing medium sized compact bunches, with small-medium greenish-white fruit. Ripens very early

Lakemont

Seedless	Table, Juice	Green
-----------------	---------------------	--------------

Hardy and sweet. Modeled after the famous California Thompson, this hardy white grape is a bit smaller, but much sweeter. The vine has large tight clusters of small to medium sized greenish-yellow berries with tender skin, having milder but excellent flavor. Ripens early to mid-season.

Ontario

Semi-Seedless	Table, Juice	Red
----------------------	---------------------	------------

crisp, juicy flesh and mild sweet taste of the semi-seedless table grape is ideal for eating fresh out-of-hand. The fragrant flavor and vibrant color makes them a perfect ingredient for desserts, sauces, jams, jellies and juice. Ripens mid-season

Reliance

Seedless	Table	Pink/Red
-----------------	--------------	-----------------

Produces large clusters of round, red, medium-sized berries with a semi-slip skin. The skins are tender and the flesh is soft, with a sweet flavor. Sugar-sweet, rosy fruit is big and plump, perfect for snacking. Ripens in late August

Somerset

Seedless	Table, Jelly	Red
-----------------	---------------------	------------

A unique, strawberry-like flavor. This heavy bearer will give you compact clusters of medium-sized table grapes that are good for fresh eating and making jelly. The fruit starts out pink, but becomes much sweeter and more flavorful after ripening on the vine until turning a full red color. Mo

Thompson

Seedless	Table	Green
-----------------	--------------	--------------

Grown for its large bunches of small, sweet, mild-flavored, green grapes. Good mid-season table grape. The one you see in the grocery store. Unbeatable for fresh use! Ripens mid-season.

Vanessa

Seedless	Table, Raisin	Red
-----------------	----------------------	------------

Crisp, sweet fruit. Good for fresh use, or it also a good raisin. The firm, fruity berries of this red seedless are easy to compare to Flame Seedless. The red color of Vanessa is more uniform, but more of a brick red than the brighter red of Flame. Ripens mid-season.
