Midseason	Fruit size: Medium
-----------	--------------------

A midseason crop of delicious blueberries follow showy pink-tinged white flowers. More productive than others due to larger size. High sugar content, great for jams, baking or eating fresh. Yellow, bronze, orange and red fall color.

Bountiful Blue

Midseason	Fruit size: Large
-----------	-------------------

An award winning variety with the bluest foliage of all blueberries! Pink-blushed flowers produce a large crop of large, sweet, juicy berries on a compact, mounded shrub. Perfect for massing in the landscape or featuring in large containers. **Self fertile**, though planting another variety may yield a more prolific harvest. Requires just 150-200 winter chill hours. Semi-evergreen in mild climates.

Sunshine Blue

Mid-Late	Fruit size: Medium
----------	--------------------

One of the best for mild-winter areas, this low-chill selection is perfect for smaller gardens or containers. Blue-green foliage and showy pink to white flowers provide ornamental value, followed by an abundant crop of fruit. **Self fertile**, but yields best when planted with another variety. Semi-evergreen.

Bluejay

Early-mid	Fruit Size: Medium-Large
-----------	--------------------------

This native American variety ripens in July and yields heavily for weeks. The 5-6' tall bushes become a blaze of crimson in the fall, so they are ideal arranged as an informal hedge. You'll have fresh blueberries for pies and preserves for many, many years. **Needs pollinizer**

Earlibird

Early	Fruit Size: Large
-------	-------------------

Deliciously sweet eaten fresh, or when flavor is captured in pie or preserves. Firm, large berries with resistance to cracking. Early season. Height: 6' - 8'. **Needs pollinizer**

Duke

Early	Fruit Size: Medium-Large
-------	--------------------------

Duke Blueberry is a heavy, consistent producer you can count on to provide you with delicious fruit every year. The medium to large berries are very firm and retain their fresh quality longer than other varieties, so you can easily store some or share a few with friends and neighbors. Duke is particularly renowned for its superb berry with a mildly tart flavor. **Needs pollinizer**

Elliott

Very late	Fruit Size: Large
-----------	-------------------

Big and flavorful. This late-season variety will give you ½” berries that are firm, easy-to-pick and perfect for fresh eating or cooking. Lovely pink-tinged flowers will grace your landscape each spring. Ripens in August.

Self-pollinating.

Chandler

Mid-Late	Fruit Size: Huge
----------	------------------

One of the largest blueberry varieties! This attractive plant produces large, sweet and juicy berries that are delicious fresh. Very cold-hardy, even in temperatures as low as -10° to -15°F. Ripens in July.

Legacy

Late	Fruit Size: Large
------	-------------------

A very productive blueberry that produces firm, sweet fruit for an extended period in late mid-season. Fruit is large and stores well; plants are vigorous, upright and have good disease resistance. Great taste from a beautiful bush. Enjoy consistently high yields of delicious fruit year after year. **Needs pollinizer**

Patriot

Early	Fruit Size: Large
-------	-------------------

Deep blue, highly flavored fruit ripens in July and is larger and firmer than most. Produces up to 20 lbs. of fruit per plant. Patriot is adaptable to many soil types, shows good resistance to root rot, and can withstand wet soils better than other varieties. **Needs pollinizer**

Blueray

Early-Mid	Fruit Size: Large
-----------	-------------------

Very sweet, light blue fruits resist cracking. Ripen in July and the harvest goes on for weeks. Enjoy up to 20 pounds of blueberries on each bush! This abundant producer will give you buckets of delicious, aromatic, light blue berries that won't crack. Also an ideal pollinator for most other varieties. Cold-hardy. Ripens in July. **Self-pollinating**

Berkeley

Mid-Late	Fruit Size: Large
----------	-------------------

Late midseason blueberry and carries attractive powder blue fruit with a pleasing light flavor and good dessert quality. 'Berkeley' is the most popular home garden varieties. Sweet flavor and not subject to cracking.
